Championships

There are no solo championship competitions. Each round of the championship will be judged by one adjudicator to give a solo competition result. Thus, at the end of the championships, awards will be given for three individual solo competitions, plus the overall championship result. Dancers are required to perform the mandatory number of bars in Preliminary and Open Championships; i.e. 48 bars for the reel and treble jig, and 40 bars for the slip jig and hornpipe. If there are 5 or more boys registered for any one competition, the Feis Committee will split the championships into two categories - boys and girls. In the event competitions are split, the dances will be numbered as follows: 701B (boys), 701G (girls), 702B, 702G, 703B, 703G etc.

All Preliminary and Open Championships will dance two at a time.

Feis Rules

- 1-29. Rules 1-29 of the North American Feis Commission are adopted for this Feis.
30. A competitors' age will be determined as of January 1, 2010.
31. Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.
32. Competitions with three entrants or less may be combined with other competitions at the discretion of the Feis Committee.
33. Trophy competitions may be added or combined at the discretion of the Feis Committee.
34. When awards are announced from the stage, rather than being posted, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes to receive their awards.
35. The Yeates Academy of Irish Dance, The Sheraton Hotel, The Feis Committee and anyone affiliated with the Committee in putting on the Feis, shall not be responsible or liable for any personal injury, property loss or damage incurred before, during or after the Feis, by a participant or by anyone attending the event.
36. The Feis Committee reserves the right to reject any entry for cause, to cancel or postpone all or part of the Feis and to limit competitors' performing time. The decision of the Feis Committee is final in all matters connected to the Feis.
37. Competitors must answer all questions as required by the Feis Entry Committee, including the teacher's name, and enclose the entry fee when mailing or else the entry may be rejected. Entries must be postmarked on or before the closing date or they will be subject to a late fee.
38. Submittal of entries shall constitute acceptance of these rules.
